Please help us celebrate our world-class Social Workers!

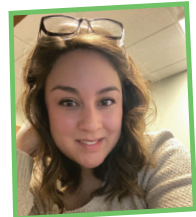
We are extremely proud of their compassion, advocacy and diligence in assuring that the needs of our residents are honored.
